Maslina was born as a mindful resort for conscious travelers looking for an authentic and local getaway, respecting the nature, people, customs, and traditions that belong to the place. The design combines stylish and modern, luxurious and informal, relaxed and serious, with a personalized touch. A model was executed where the interior and exterior coalesce using natural materials, like terra-cotta, linen, wood, Brac stone, and brushed brass. Istoria Hotel / Greece

At the sublime junction where the black volcanic sand of Perivolos Beach meets the midnight blue waters of the Aegean Sea, one finds Istoria, a 12-suite retreat designed by Interior Design Laboratorium with a unique blend of classic and contemporary aesthetics. Amenities are rounded up with the serene Elios Spa offering treatments that cure the body, soul and spirit.

Zuri Zanzibar / Tanzania

Designed by Jestico + Whiles, Zuri Zanzibar hotel resort is located in Kendwa, on the idyllic northern west shores of Zanzibar's Spice Island, Unguja. This beachfront 12hectare resort features 55 stylish bungalows, villas and suites all with spacious private terraces overlooking a 300m stretch of west-facing private beach on the Indian Ocean. The cabanas are set in small clusters just steps from the beach among a gently sloping landscape of sand, palm trees and timber walkways. A grass thatch roof extending out over a private garden subtly shades the living and relaxation space, creating a retreat where guests can relax and spend time outdoors. This arrangement differs from standard hotel layouts and is a unique design for the island.
